Having had no rain for over a month now, there is some forecast again, so hopefully the water butt will fill again. Happily I've had time to water the seeds sown a couple of weeks ago and there's a good germination on Beetroot now as well as Radish and Turnips. I've also pricked out into pots the new brassicas for later in the year. Don't be in too much haste to plant out tender things like tomatoes, courgettes and beans etc; we had a frost again during last week. There's still plenty of time to enjoy the Tulips and Wallflowers. I notice though how early the Lilac, Bearded Iris and Sweet Williams are. Probably a month ahead of what I was used too.

At Depaul UK, across our many services we are looking after and supporting around 1,000 of the most vulnerable young people in this country who are homeless or at risk of being homeless. We provide accommodation that offers an immediate answer to homelessness.

We are so grateful to our very committed and highly trained frontline staff who are adapting to the rapidly changing environment and the fear and frustration that this brings for the young people in our care. Their innovation and perseverance in the face of such immense challenge will allow Depaul to continue to provide the best possible support for young people facing homelessness.
